Abstract

The corresponding authors are invited to submit the abstracts before April 30, 2016. Abstracts (not exceeding 3500 characters including spaces) should be submitted through the NENE conference webpage.

The Program Committee will review the abstracts and inform the corresponding authors about the acceptance and the type of presentation before June 30, 2016.

Full-length papers are due by August 31, 2016. A peer review of full-length papers will be performed before including the papers in the Proceedings.

Proceedings and Publication

Proceedings containing full length peer reviewed papers presented at the conference will be published after the conference and mailed to the participants.

Contest of Young Authors

An award will be presented for the best paper prepared by a first author aged no more than 32 years. The number of co-authors should be limited to a maximum of two additional co-authors (advisers). The Young Author Award Committee will review the eligible papers and select the winner. Candidates are kindly requested to indicate their intent to participate in the contest when submitting the abstract.

Best poster award

The best poster will be selected by the Best Poster Award Committee. Posters will be evaluated according to clarity of objectives, results and conclusions, scientific relevance, as well as according to aesthetics.

Venue

Portorož is a popular place either for work or vacation at the Adriatic. The coastal towns of Piran, Izola and Koper are intertwined with narrow streets, leading to picturesque squares, encircled with mighty palaces. Vicinity of Karst offers different possibilities: visit to subterranean caves or to stud farm Lipica.
